Mike did a presentation on the new web site. It was unanimously agreed that we pay Inawire any amount owing for past services, and terminate the account for the old site. Mike will obtain a new domain name for the site, making the assumption that the club's name will be changed as planned. The cost for the domain name will be about \$15 per year. At the moment, we can manage with the free 100MB of storage supplied by Google, but we made need to spend \$50 per year for additional storage at a later date.
